

IF SOMEONE OVERDOSES DON'T ASSUME THEY'LL COME ROUND

Don't panic, put them in the recovery position
Dial 999 and ask for an ambulance
Stay with them until the ambulance arrives
If you don't

THEY MAY DIE

Watch out for overdose risks

- Mixing drugs
- Mixing drugs and alcohol
- Using heroin and methadone when tolerance is lowparticularly after a detox or break in use
- Injecting heroin and other tranquillising drugs

Watch out for signs of an overdose

- Deep snoring
- Unwakeable
- Turning blue
- Not breathing

Stay with people who may have taken too many drugs but are not yet showing signs of overdose.

If they are sleeping lie them on their side in the recovery position and keep checking them. Many people have died several hours after taking an overdose.
